**FAT HEAD'S HEAD HUNTER IPA OUT**

An Uncivilized and aggressive, dry-hopped west coast IPA. A huge dank hop infused nose of pine and citrus. Big hop flavors of citrus, pine, grapefruit and pineapple. A creamy mouthfeel and a good malt backbone work hard to balance the aggressive hops. 7% ABV

**DOUBLE IPA**

**FAT HEAD'S HOP JUJU DOUBLE IPA**

Bordering on the supernatural, Hop Juju is the perfect name for this beer as the magical hops cast their spell with intense, dank aromas of pine and citrus and big, aggressive, bitter flavors of pine, grapefruit and orange. Nicely balanced by a very sturdy malt backbone and warming alcohol. 9.5% ABV. 100 IBU

**BALTIC PORTER**

**FAT HEAD'S BATTLE AXE BALTIC PORTER**

Aromas of chocolate and dark fruit will initially assault your senses. Rich and creamy with complex flavors of dark fruits (plums, raisins and dates) and hints of coffee, chocolate, licorice and toffee. This Baltic Porter is fermented with lager yeast for a smooth, clean lager-like character. 8.2% ABV

**FAT HEAD'S BUMBLEBERRY HONEY BLUEBERRY WHEAT**

**PAULANER HEFE-WEIZEN, München Germany**

Very smooth, citrus, banana, bready taste. Very refreshing with some spiciness A bit of hop bitterness at the end. 5.5% ABV.

**PILSNER URQUELL, Czech Republic**

The world's first pilsner. Bitter hops, sweet grassy malty taste, dry and some citrus notes. Crisp and refreshing. 4.4% ABV

Nice malty, grains in the nose with noble hops. Smooth, well-balanced flavor with a crackery malt character and grassy, herbal, hops. 5% ABV

Aromas of pale sweet malt and some grassy hops. Grainy malt character with a nice balance of citrus, herbal, grassy hops. 6.5% ABV

**PALE ALE**

**SIERRA NEVADA PALE ALE, Chico, CA.**

The Quintessential Pale Ale. Nicely balanced taste of hops and malts. A Classic! Just ask Ed! 5.6% ABV.

**MAGIC HAT #9, Burlington, VT**

A smooth taste of apricot with a bready malt backbone. 5.1% ABV.

**BOULDER HAZED AND INFUSED (NITRO), Boulder CO**

Aroma of light toasted malt and citrus and piney hops. Well balanced with smooth toasted malt throughout and citrus hop bitterness. 4.8% ABV

**FURTHERMORE "PROPER" ENGLISH PALE ALE,**

Malt and grain in the nose. Good balance between a pale malt body and mild dried citrus hop notes, a little bready and a touch sweet. 4.5% ABV

**FURTHERMORE KNOT STOCK, Spring Green, WI**

Pale ale brewed with Black Pepper. Nose of caramel malt, hops and hints of black pepper. Caramel malt softens the play of the pepper, but not for long as it grows as you drink. A nice bitter hop finish. 5.5% ABV

**IPA/DOUBLE IPA**

**DOGFISH HEAD 90 MINUTE IPA, Milton, DE**

Very smooth with a thick, sweet malt body. Lots of bitterness with a ton of hop oil flavor front to back. 9% ABV.

**GREEN FLASH WEST COAST IPA, VISTA, CA**

Aroma is hoppy: pine dank, nice. Taste is a blast of piney, citrusy, hops followed by a faint malt character and a long, resinous finish. 7% ABV

**BOULDER MOJO RISIN' IPA, Boulder, CO**

Citrus, grapefruit and caramel malt in the nose. Great citrus grapefruit flavor with a big malt backing. Nicely balanced Double IPA. 10% ABV

**IRISH RED**

**GREAT LAKES CONWAY'S IRISH ALE, Cleveland OH**

Smell is sweet caramel, with a touch of herbal hops. Taste is big, sweet malt, with caramel toastiness and a flash of hop bitterness. 6.5% ABV

**HARPOON CELTIC ALE, Boston, MA**

Clean malt and fruit in the nose. Smooth with a nice toasted malt sweetness, a touch of caramel and fruit. Mild hop bitterness. 5.4% ABV

## BOCK/DOPPLEBOCK

### ROGUE DEAD GUY ALE, Newport, OR

A bock that's an ale? Caramel malt, some butterscotch, toffee. Nice hop profile. 6.5% ABV.

### ANCHOR BOCK BEER, San Francisco CA

Roasted malt, caramel and toffee in the nose. The palate is soft with sweet toasted bread, caramel and toffee and a dash of hops. 5.5% ABV

### ROGUE JOHN JOHN DEAD GUY ALE, Newport, OR

Dead Guy Ale aged in Dead Guy Whiskey Barrels. Sweet malt, vanilla and caramel in the nose. Delicious caramel maltiness with some grain and hints of oak, vanilla and whiskey. 6.4% ABV

## AMBER/RED ALE

### SMITHWICKS (SMIT-ICKS), Dublin, Ireland

Smooth, creamy, biscuity, toasted malt. Light hops 4.5% ABV

### TRÖEGS NUGGET NECTAR, Harrisburg, PA

Strong, citrusy, grapefruit aroma with caramel malt. Pine and grapefruit up front with a good amount of hop bitterness. A nice sweet caramel malt backbone balances this beer beautifully. 7.5% ABV

## STOUT

### VICTORY STORMKING STOUT, Downingtown, PA

Aroma of roasted malt, chocolate and coffee. Flavors of roasted malt, dark chocolate, bitter coffee, molasses and earthy tree bark. 9.1% ABV

### FURTHERMORE THREE FEET DEEP, Spring Green, WI

A dry Irish Stout brewed with peat smoked malt. Aroma of roasted, smoke and a touch of coffee. Smooth with roasted malt flavors, bitter coffee, dark chocolate and a touch of peat smoke. 5.5% ABV

### GUINNESS STOUT, Dublin, Ireland

Creamy, roasted malt, dry with light bitterness. 4.5% ABV.

### FOUNDERS PORTER, Grand Rapids, MI

Aroma of deeply roasted malt, chocolate and caramel. Taste of roasted malt, caramel, coffee, chocolate and brown sugar. Light Hops 6.5% ABV

## AMERICAN STRONG ALE

### STONE ARROGANT BASTARD ALE, Escondido, CA

Big Malt, Big Hops. Very balanced with flavors of roasted caramel malt, molasses and piney citrusy, bitter hops. Are you worthy? 7.2% ABV

### TERRAPIN BIG HOPPY MONSTER, ATHENS, GA

A great smell of citric, floral hops and some sweet malts. Chewy with a great mix of hops and a backbone of roasted, caramel malts 8.3% ABV

Caramel malts with a nice hop balance. Sweetness at the finish. A great beer. 6.2% ABV.

A very nice, old-school Amber Lager. Simple, sturdy and tasty. 4.9% ABV.

### NEWCASTLE BROWN ALE, Edinburgh, Scotland

Caramel, biscuit, nutty, a touch of toffee. Very drinkable. 4.7% ABV

## BELGIAN STRONG DARK ALE

### 21ST AMENDMENT MONK'S BLOOD, San Francisco, CA

Complex nose of dark fruit, chocolate, malt, cake batter. Flavors of rich sweet malt, dark fruit, figs, citrus, vanilla and some booze. 8.5% ABV

## BELGIAN WITBIER

### HOEGAARDEN WHITE, Hoegaarden Belgium

Taste of lemon, coriander, orange, Smooth and very refreshing. 5% ABV

## BELGIAN QUADRUPAL (QUAD)

### SCALDIS, Leuze-Pipaix Belgium

Aromas of peppery sweet alcohol, yeast and ripe tropical fruit. Creamy and sherry-like with warming alcohol and sweet cake-like malt flavors. Yeasty with fruit esters and a sharp, sweet finish. 12% ABV

## BELGIAN DUBBEL

### MAREDSOUS 8, Breendonk-Purrs, Belgium

Sweet malt with flavors of raisins and plums. Hints of brown sugar, molasses apricots and chocolate. Some tartness in finish. 8% ABV

### LINDEMANS LAMBICS, Vlezenbeek, Belgium

**FRAMBOISE (raspberry)** - Tart raspberry up front fades to sweetness. 4% ABV

**POMME (apple)** Crisp tart apple aroma and flavor. Refreshing. 4% ABV

**PECHE (peach)** - Pure peach nose Sweet, tart, natural peach flavors. 8.5oz \$5

## CIDER (NOT A BEER)

### WOODCHUCK AMBER APPLE CIDER, Springfield, VT

Refreshing with flavors of fresh apples and white wine. A nice balance between sweet and sour with a crisp finish. **Gluten Free!** 5% ABV.
