**FAT HEAD'S HEADHUNTER IPA**

An Uncivilized and aggressive, dry-hopped west coast IPA. A huge dank hop infused nose of pine and citrus. Big hop flavors of citrus, pine, grapefruit and pineapple. A creamy mouthfeel and a good malt backbone work hard to balance the aggressive hops. 7% ABV

**FAT HEAD'S HOP JUJU DOUBLE IPA**

Bordering on the supernatural, Hop Juju is the perfect name for this beer as the magical hops cast their spell with intense, dank aromas of pine and citrus and big, aggressive, bitter flavors of pine, grapefruit and orange. Nicely balanced by a very sturdy malt backbone and warming alcohol.

Imported German Malts give this Fest Bier a deep copper color. Nice aromas of toasted grains with a toasted, crackery malt flavor which is balanced by imported German Noble Hops. This beer is smooth and highly drinkable. 5% ABV

**IPA/DOUBLE IPA**

**DOGFISH HEAD 90 MINUTE IPA, Milton, DE**

Very smooth with a thick, sweet malt body. Lots of bitterness with a ton of hop oil flavor front to back. 9% ABV.

**BALLAST POINT SCULPIN (Double Dry Hopped) IPA, San Diego, CA**

The nose is full of deep tropical fruit, spice and sticky pine. Big hop explosion of citrus, bitter grapefruit, pineapple, orange and passion fruit. A nice robust mix of caramel and bready malts to balance. 7 % ABV

**21st AMENDMENT IPA, San Francisco, CA**

The aroma is hop forward, grapefruit and grassy and some sweet fruit. Crisp citrus, piney hops but not overly bitter with a nice bready malt backbone. A very drinkable IPA. 7% ABV

**SMUTTYNOSE IPA, Portsmouth, NH**

Clean and bitter from start to finish, with a heavy hand of grapefruit hop flavor. The pale maltiness holds the beer together quite well. 6.9% ABV

**VICTORY HOP WALLOP, Downingtown, PA**

Citrusy with waves of pine oil in the nose. Intense citrusy hop flavor and bitterness with a toasted maltiness and underlying alcohol. 8.5% ABV

**BOULDER MOJO IPA (NITRO), Boulder, CO**

Nose of juicy grapefruit and biscuit malt. Very creamy with sweet caramel malt backbone and big citrus hop flavor and bitterness. 7.2% ABV

**SIERRA NEVADA PALE ALE, Chico, CA.**

The Quintessential Pale Ale. Nicely balanced taste of hops and malts. A Classic! Just ask Ed! 5.6% ABV.

Aroma of floral, citrus hops with some sweet malt. Caramel and bready malts and grapefruit, citrus hops create a balanced flavor. 5.4% ABV

Ripe fruit, citrus and caramel in the nose. Medium bodied and crisp with assertive citrus hop bitterness and nutty, malt sweetness. 5% ABV

**STONE ARROGANT BASTARD ALE, Escondido, CA**

Big Malt, Big Hops. Very balanced with flavors of roasted caramel malt, molasses and piney citrusy, bitter hops. Are you worthy? 7.2% ABV

**THE DUCK RABBIT MÄRZEN Farmville, NC**

Aroma of toasted bread with flavors of sweet roasted malt, bready, biscuity with hints of honey and a crisp, clean finish. 7% ABV

### ROGUE DEAD GUY ALE, Newport, OR

A bock that's an ale? Caramel malt, some butterscotch, toffee. Nice hop profile. 6.5% ABV.

### SIERRA NEVADA GLISSADE GOLDEN BOCK, Chico, CA

A malty aroma with earthy, grassy hops. Malty and slightly sweet with hints of honey with earthy, floral hops and a clean finish. 6.4% ABV

## VIENNA LAGER

### GREAT LAKES ELLIOT NESS LAGER, Cleveland, OH

Caramel malts with a nice hop balance. Sweetness at the finish. A great beer. 6.2% ABV.

### YUENGLING LAGER, Pottsville, PA

A very nice, old-school Amber Lager. Simple, sturdy and tasty. 4.9% ABV.

## PORTER

### FLYING DOG GONZO IMPERIAL PORTER, Frederick, MD

Nice smoky roastiness, dark bitter chocolate and dark fruit. The hopping is dry, citrusy, and woody 7.8% ABV.  
12oz, \$6

### DUCK RABBIT BALTIC PORTER, Farmville, NC

Pours thick and black with aromas and flavors of dark roasted malts, chocolate and dark fruits. This one goes down smooth. 9% ABV

## STOUT

### BELL'S DOUBLE CREAM STOUT, Kalamazoo MI

Sweet, roasty aroma with molasses and chocolate Creamy with roasted malt, coffee and vanilla hints and a bittersweet chocolate finish. 6.1% ABV

### SOUTHERN TIER CHOKLAT, Lakewood, NY

A huge chocolate aroma with some coffee and roasted malt. A grownup's chocolate milk. Creamy, rich with big favors of milk chocolate, dark chocolate bitterness, sweet roasted malt and some coffee with a slight caramel edge and some alcohol. 9.1% ABV

### GUINNESS STOUT, Dublin, Ireland

Creamy, roasted malt, dry with light bitterness. 4.5% ABV.

## AMBER/RED ALE

### SMITHWICKS (SMIT-ICKS), Dublin, Ireland

Smooth, creamy, biscuity, toasted malt. Light hops 4.5% ABV  
16oz, \$5

## PILSNER

### PILSNER URQUELL, Czech Republic

The world's first pilsner. Bitter hops, sweet grassy malty taste, dry and some citrus notes. Crisp and refreshing. 4.4% ABV

### HEAVY SEAS ÜBER PILS, Baltimore, MD

A strong malt presence of sweet toasted grains in the nose with grassy hops. Initial crisp, clean flavor with sharp hop bitterness then the sweet malt becomes almost caramel-like. Some alcohol is present as is warms. 7% ABV

### MILLER LITE, Milwaukee, WI

Triple Hop Brewed? Hey, we aim to please all. 4% ABV

### PAULANER HEFE-WEIZEN, München Germany

Very smooth, citrus, banana, bready taste. Very refreshing with some spiciness A bit of hop bitterness at the end. 5.5% ABV.

### HARPOON GINGER WHEAT, Boston, MA

The ginger is dominating in the nose with some wheat and fruit. A nice flavor of ginger with hints of banana & citrus and some clove. 7% ABV

## BELGIAN WITBIER

### HOEGAARDEN WHITE, Hoegaarden Belgium

Taste of lemon, coriander, orange, Smooth and very refreshing. 5% ABV

### BELLS WINTER WHITE, Kalamazoo, MI

Banana and clove in the nose with some malt sweetness. Nice full banana, pear, and clove flavor with a bit of coriander and wheat. 4.5% ABV

## BELGIAN DUBBEL

### MAREDSOUS 8, Breendonk-Purrs, Belgium

Sweet malt with flavors of raisins and plums. Hints of brown sugar, molasses apricots and chocolate. Some tartness in finish. 8% ABV

## FRUIT LAMBIC

### LINDEMANS LAMBICS, Vlezenbeek, Belgium

FRAMBOISE (raspberry) - Tart raspberry up front fades to sweetness. 4% ABV

POMME (apple) Crisp tart apple aroma and flavor. Refreshing. 4% ABV

PECHE (peach) - Pure peach nose Sweet, tart, natural peach flavors. 8.5oz \$5

## FRUIT BEER

### 21st AMENDMENT WATERMELON WHEAT, Bangor, ME

Tart watermelon in the nose with some wheat and grass. Very drinkable with tastes of wheat, yeast and a hint of watermelon. 4.9% ABV

### WOODCHUCK AMBER APPLE CIDER, Springfield, VT

Refreshing with flavors of fresh apples and white wine. A nice balance between sweet and sour with a crisp finish. **Gluten Free!** 5% ABV.
