A robust porter brewed with malted barley that was smoked over Adler wood by our brewers on-site. Rich smoky aromas greet your nose while flavors of dark chocolate, smoke, some roasted malt and a bit of coffee hit the tastebuds. Finishes nice and dry.

Aroma is toasty malt, some caramel sweetness and herbal hops. A solid malt backbone with a touch of caramel sweetness and a nice clean herbal hop finish. Another fine German lager from head brewer Andy Rich. 5.6% ABV

DOGFISH HEAD 60 MINUTE IPA, Milton, DE

Aroma of cookie-like malt and floral, citrus hops. Lots of fresh hop oil flavor, with citric and bitter herbal tones and a doughy toasted grain mix. 6% ABV

Aroma of peach, tangerine and grassy hops. Well balanced between citrus, hops and sweet malt. A dry and slightly bitter finish. 7.1% ABV

Caramel malt and piney hops in the nose. Rich caramel malt sweetness balanced by a nice piney, citrus hop flavor and bitterness. 6.7% ABV

Aroma of sweet caramel malt and pungent hops. Sweet caramel malt flavor with toffee hints and a blast of citrusy, grapefruit hops. 8.7% ABV

Spicy, citrus hop aroma with some caramel. Crisp and hoppy with citrus and pine and a nice malt backbone and bitter finish.. 7% ABV

Sweet grain, honey and grassy hops in the nose. Sweet bready malt with a nice clean herbal, grassy hop bitterness. 4.5% ABV

AMBER/ RED ALE

SMITHWICKS (SMIT-ICKS), Dublin, Ireland

Smooth, creamy, biscuity, toasted malt. Light hops 4.5% ABV

PORTER

TRÖEGS DEAD RECKONING PORTER, Harrisburg, PA

Roasted malts, light chocolate and earth hops in the aroma and flavor with hints of coffee and vanilla. Finished clean and slightly bitter. 5.4% ABV

STOUT

GUINNESS STOUT, Dublin, Ireland

Creamy, roasted malt, dry with light bitterness and hints of coffee and chocolate. A classic dry Irish stout. 4.5% ABV.

STOUDT'S FAT DOG IMPERIAL OATMEAL STOUT, Adamstown, PA

Aroma of sweet roasted malts, chocolate, and oats. Flavor of coffee, chocolate, roasted malts. Finishes with clean bittering hops. 9% ABV

SIERRA NEVADA BIGFOOT ALE, Chico, CA

Aroma of fresh hops, grapefruit and pine, sweet caramel malt and fruit. A foundation of caramel and toasted malt sweetness balance by pungent, bitter hops with fruity esters and warming alcohol. 9.6% ABV

BOCK/DOPPLEBOCK

ROGUE DEAD GUY ALE, Newport, OR

A bock that's an ale? Caramel malt, some butterscotch, toffee. Nice hop profile. 6.5% ABV.

HERB/SPICED BEER

ROGUE JUNIPER ALE, Newport, OR

Aroma of honey, bread and some juniper spice. Flavor has sweet honey and malt with medium, earthy bitterness and some spice. 5.3% ABV

VIENNA LAGER/ AMBER LAGER

GREAT LAKES ELLIOT NESS LAGER, Cleveland, OH

Caramel malts with a nice hop balance. Sweetness at the finish. A great beer. 6.2% ABV.

A very nice, old-school Amber Lager. Simple, sturdy and tasty. 4.9% ABV.

AMERICAN STRONG ALE

STONE ARROGANT BASTARD ALE, Escondido, CA

Big Malt, Big Hops. Very balanced with flavors of roasted caramel malt, molasses and piney citrusy, bitter hops. Are you worthy? 7.2% ABV

BEAR REPUBLIC HOP ROD RYE, Cloverdale, CA

A rye IPA that I like to consider an American Strong ale due to the strong malt character and the dark color. It is certainly hoppy in the nose with pine and citrus with lots of bready caramel malt as well. The flavor is much of the same with rye spice coming through as well. 8% ABV

BRAGGOT- made by blending spices and herbs with mead and beer

BROOKLYN BUZZ BOMB ALE, Brooklyn, NY

The aroma is moderately sweet with some honey, fruit and floral notes. The flavor is earthy with a nice dose of honey, wheat and a woody profile. Some yeasty spice, clove, alcohol and just enough hops for balance. 8% ABV

BELGIAN WITBIER

HOEGAARDEN WHITE, Hoegaarden Belgium

Taste of lemon, coriander, orange, Smooth and very refreshing. 5% ABV

CORONADO ORANGE AVENUE WIT, Coronado, CA

Aroma is tangy and spicy, with light clove, orange zest, and a hop zing. The flavor is orangey and spicy, with clove and allspice, and there is a good hop bitterness on the back end 5.2% ABV

MAREDSOUS 10, Breendonk-Purrs, Belgium

Aroma of dried grain, nuts, yeast, apples and pears. Flavors of yeast nuts, grain, apple, pear, pineapple, alcohol and clean bitter hops. 10% ABV

BELGIAN DUBBEL

MAREDSOUS 8, Breendonk-Purrs, Belgium

Sweet malt with flavors of raisins and plums. Hints of brown sugar, molasses apricots and chocolate. Some tartness in finish. 8% ABV

FRAMBOISE (raspberry) - Lots of juicy raspberries in the nose. Tart raspberry up front fades to sweetness. 4% ABV

POMME (apple) Crisp tart apple aroma, almost "jolly rancher". Clean sour tart apple flavor. Not much sweetness. 4% ABV

PECHE (peach) Nose of sweet peaches and some earthy funk. This is all peach. Sweet lingering peach flavor that finishes somewhat tart, 4% ABV

CIDER (NOT A BEER)

WOODCHUCK GRANNY SMITH APPLE CIDER, Middlebury, VT

Aromas and flavors of tart green apples with a wine like character. Light and spritzy. **Gluten Free!** 5.3% ABV
